

Drink Deep of the Living Water

Have you ever been really thirsty? Your mouth is as dry as a sandy, rocky desert; tongue moisture-less and throat scratchy. All you want is a drink of water to relieve this incessant thirst and you are sure you are dehydrated. There is an app for that; it's called plant nanny; a water reminder. blogger wrote, "I downloaded the app. Offered a cute little cartoon plant, I set the app with my weight and read my results. The plant nanny determined how much water I must drink to keep me and my little imaginary plant alive and well. The seedling face blinked at me with trusting animated eyes. I found myself trapped; being forced to drink enough water to nurture the plant into a blooming dependent illusion."

Our physical need for water is similar to our spiritual need for something greater than ourselves. There is a longing like a thirst that we try to fill in many ways.

In the book of John chapter 4, a Samaritan women walks to Jacob's well at the sixth hour to draw water, unbeknownst to her, she is spiritually dehydrated.

"Jacob's well was there and Jesus, tired as he was from the journey, sat down by the well. When a Samaritan woman came to draw water, Jesus said to her. "Will you give me a drink?" The Samaritan woman said to him, "You are a Jew and I am a Samaritan woman, how can you ask me for a drink?" (For Jews do not associate with Samaritans.) Jesus answered her," If

you knew the gift of God and who it is that asks you for a drink, you would have asked him and he would have given you living water." John 4:6-10

Jesus was referring to the spiritual life. He said, If you knew the gift of God (Jesus)

And who it is that asks you for a drink (Jesus the Son of God)

You would have asked him (Jesus) and he (Jesus) would have given you living water.

The Samaritan woman stuck in the physical realm said, "Sir, you have nothing to draw with and the well is deep."

The woman was locked in the practical, physical life not grasping the dialog with Jesus who was focused on the spiritual life, living water. This dialog is a good example of how to read the Bible, the Living Word. To not be focused on the physical aspects of the scripture, but open your heart to the spiritual world of Jesus, the Kingdom of God.

Jesus offered the woman Himself, as **He is the living water**, which satisfies our longing soul, our thirst for a spiritual relationship. This is an invitation to the world to quench their spiritual thirst with the living water of Jesus to experience His divine nature, the joy of being a child of God.

Jesus offers each of us His divine nature like an exquisite banquet, the vast array of His Godly characteristics. Peter explains "His divine nature has given us everything we need for life and godliness through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness." 2 Peter 1:3

His divine nature banquet includes His unconditional love, justice, forgiveness for the repentant heart, salvation, grace, mercy. knowledge, all wisdom, all understanding, comfort, insight, revelation. intervention, faithfulness. protection from guidance, healing, evil, righteousness, peace that transcends understanding, patience, His presence. strength. We can often go to the fountain of living water to fill our lives with His spiritual nourishment.

The Samaritan woman knew of a Messiah, and Jesus acknowledged He was the Messiah. Then the scripture continues describing how she brought the whole town to the well and Jesus began His message, the transformation of lives to conform with His. Jesus stayed in the town for two days, continuing His gospel message. "Because of his words, many more became believers." Jesus has the power to transform lives as He did in the village of Sycar. Accepting Jesus as your personal savior, living a life pleasing to God, "Walking Humbly with God" can give us the hope of eternal life with God in heaven. "but whosoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst, indeed the water I give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life." John 4:14

The Living Water is Jesus and He will quench our thirst for our deep spiritual needs. Yet there is more.

There is a soulful paradox. While we are filled with Jesus, there remains a deep seated longing still. The Living Water of Jesus is the beginning of a journey. "That is the heavenly birth without which we cannot see the kingdom of God. It is however, not an end but an inception, for now begins the glorious pursuit, the heart's happy exploration of the infinite riches of the Godhead." A.W. Tozer The Pursuit of God. The door is opened to His divine nature and there remains a longing, a deep desire to learn more, grow more, drink more deeply of the Living Water. 2 Peter 3: 18 "But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord." The Living Word in the Bible continues to teach us life lessons when we have a desire to pursue God, with a teachable heart and longing for an intimate communion with Jesus.

John 4:42 "We KNOW that this man really is the Savior of the world." Our Messiah -- The beginning of the lifelong pursuit of Him.

<u>Devotion and prayer</u>: 2 Corinthians 5:14-21 "For Christ's love compels us, because we are convinced that one died for all, and therefore all died. And he died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for him who died for them and was raised again. So from now on we regard no one from a worldly point of view. Though we once regarded Christ in this way, we do so no longer. Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come! All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them.
