

### The Living Word!

We don't often connect words that are spoken with giving life, or understand a person to be embodied in spoken word. But we have one notable exception; and that is with God, and more specifically, with Jesus Christ.

From the Creation story in Genesis 1, we know that God created the heavens and the earth by speaking them into existence. But it wasn't just matter, or *material* things, that the heavens and earth are made of – land, water, etc. – it was *living* things – plants, fish, birds, creatures, and mankind. Day by day, and one by one, God spoke. He said, "Let there be...," and it was. So there was life being given as He breathed and spoke in the days of Creation.

We know that God, the Father, was there, and according to Genesis 1:2, we know that the Spirit of God was there, on Day 1, also. But was the second person of the Godhead, the pre-incarnate Son of God, there as well? ... Yes, indeed He was.

We get some hints of this when God says, in Genesis 1:26:

26 Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, in our likeness...

Someone else, besides God, the Father, was participating in the creation process because he uses the plural pronouns "us," and "our." And also, the Hebrew word that is translated "God," is the word, "Elohim." This is actually a plural word. So this is a conversation between the persons of the Godhead: the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

But this much becomes clearer, when the Apostle John begins his gospel in the New Testament. He is writing about Jesus, and he is clearly awestruck as he contemplates all that he had experienced as he walked the roads of Galilee, Judea, and Samaria with Him. Listen to what he says, as he introduces Jesus to his hearers. He says:

1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was with God in the beginning. 3 Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. 4 In him was life, and that life was the light of men. ... 14 The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth. John 1:1-4, 14

He calls Jesus, the Word, which in Greek is "the Logos," and says that the Logos was with God in the beginning, and that the Logos was God. The word "logos" generally refers to thought or reason that is expressed or spoken. And John seems to be aware that among the Greek philosophers they referred to divine reason and divine wisdom and revelation as the Logos. But the Greek philosophers never personified this idea like John did.

John saw Jesus as the embodiment of divine expression of reason, wisdom, and revelation – that He was God, and that, as Creator and God, life was in Him as well. He was the source of life from the beginning; and as the Logos, He spoke everything into existence. And everything that had been made, was made through Him.

But most remarkable to John was that the Logos became flesh, "and dwelt among us," he said. John witnessed His glory, so he knew that Jesus was God, the Son, and that He had come from the

Father. John expands a little more on that in his first epistle, or letter. Notice what he says:

1 That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked at and our hands have touched-this we proclaim concerning the Word of life. 2 The life appeared; we have seen it and testify to it, and we proclaim to you the eternal life, which was with the Father and has appeared to us. 3 We proclaim to you what we have seen and heard, so that you also may have fellowship with us. And our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son, Jesus Christ.

1 John 1:1-4

Jesus Christ, the Son, is the Word of life. He is the source and revealer of eternal life. He was from the beginning, and with the Father, yet He came and appeared in flesh and blood in order to establish a way for us to enter eternal life and to have fellowship with the Father, and His Son.

The Old Testament reveals Him too, but in more subtle ways. When you read through the Old Testament, you will find many places where it says that "the Word of the LORD came to" a variety of individuals – Abraham, Samuel, Nathan, Solomon, Jehu, Elijah, Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezekiel, Haggai, and Zechariah. It might seem that this is merely a way of saying that the Holy Spirit gave these prophets a message to deliver from the LORD. But if you look a little deeper, you might find a more unique presence of the Word in these cases. We also find Abraham, Jacob, Moses, Gideon and others in the presence of the angel of the LORD, or persons, identified as the LORD, but manifested in another form.

In many of these cases, the scribes recognized these unique appearances as the Word (Logos) also, and when they wrote the Targams, translations in Aramaic used in the synagogues, the scribes inserted the Aramaic word "Memra" in these places, where in the Hebrew it would be "YHWH." And "Memra" has the

But even when the word of the LORD means the words given through the Holy Spirit to be spoken or recorded by the prophets, it is still the "life-giving" word of God, even if it is not a reference to the second person of the Godhead. In fact, all Scripture is infused with God's life-giving power. As we see in Hebrews 4:

12 For the word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart. 13 Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account.

Hebrews 4:12-13

Everything God says, or *has* said, is alive, living, and life-giving. But look for the revelation of Christ, as the living Word. He is the focal point. It is through Jesus, the Son of God, alone that we are given life – eternal life, and an inheritance in His Father's house. "I am the way, the truth, and the life," Jesus said, "No one comes to Father, except by me."

Is your life focused and centered on the Living Word, on Jesus, the Christ?

16 Don't be deceived, my dear brothers. 17 Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows. 18 He chose to give us birth through the word of truth, that we might be a kind of firstfruits of all he created.

James 1:16-18

He is still in the creation business. Let Him breathe life into your soul.

Pastoral Counseling: Continues as planned.


#### Old and New Business:



The next Elder's meeting will be on Wednesday, January 10th





