

The Victory Christ Jesus Gives Us

Here it is, it's time again to celebrate Easter, and all that comes with it. The death and resurrection of Jesus Christ really is a tremendous thing to celebrate, because of the great impact it has had on the world and all of humankind. And although we talk about the events that took place year after year, it is what was accomplished, and the victory it has brought us that is most important and significant.

Paul wrote about the resurrection of Jesus in 1 Corinthians 15. He tells us that Jesus' resurrection is significant on many fronts. He said that it proves that there is indeed a resurrection of the dead. It proves that our resurrected bodies (our spiritual bodies) will be different than our physical ones: that they will be of a different nature – a spiritual nature – that we can't fully describe, beyond maybe what the disciples said about Jesus after His resurrection. But Paul also said that the resurrection is victory over sin and death, THROUGH Jesus Christ, for those of us who call Him Lord. Listen to his words here:

50 "I declare to you, brothers, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God, nor does the perishable inherit the imperishable. 51 Listen, I tell you a mystery: We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed- 52 in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed. 53 For the perishable must clothe itself with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality. 54 When the perishable has been clothed with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality, then the saying that is written will come true: "Death has been swallowed up in victory."

55 "Where, O death, is your victory? Where, O death, is your sting?"

56 The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. 57 But thanks be to God! He

gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

58 Therefore, my dear brothers, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain."

1 Corinthians 15:50-58

The resurrection, for those in Christ, means that both death and sin were defeated, and it was Jesus Christ who made that possible. Before Jesus came that wasn't possible – our flesh was too weak, the standard of the law of God too high, and too holy. But Jesus came to overcome all of that, and to enable us to do it, too. Paul explains how that worked in Romans 8:

1 "Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, 2 because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death. 3 For what the law was powerless to do in that it was weakened by the flesh, God did by sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh to be a sin offering. And so he condemned sin in the flesh, 4 in order that the righteous requirements of the law might be fully met in us, who do not live according to the flesh but according to the Spirit."

Notice that this applies to those of us, who are in Christ Jesus, AND who do NOT live according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.

The law was powerless, because it was weakened by the flesh. No one was able to keep it. But Jesus came and did several things: He fulfilled the law, overcoming sin; He became our sin offering to set us free from the law of sin and death; and He brought with Him a new covenant – the law of the Spirit of life. So now, being set free from sin in Christ, when we live according to the Spirit of life, and the new law of the Spirit, we overcome the flesh, and the righteous requirements of

the law are fully met in us. This was impossible without Christ. But Thanks be to God, Jesus has given us victory!

Jesus also gives us victory over Satan as we hold onto our testimony and faith. Listen to what John said he heard in his vision:

10 Then I heard a loud voice in heaven say:

"Now have come the salvation and the power and the kingdom of our God, and the authority of his Christ. For the accuser of our brothers, who accuses them before our God day and night, has been hurled down.

11 They overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony; they did not love their lives so much as to shrink from death.

12 Therefore rejoice, you heavens and you who dwell in them!

Revelation 12:10-12

We all know Satan is a formidable enemy. But, by the blood of Christ, the authority of Christ, and the word our testimony, he too is overcome.

To overcome Satan, the flesh, sin, and death – that's a pretty good list. But there's another enemy Jesus gives us victory over. He gives us victory to overcome the world.

1"Everyone who believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of God, and everyone who loves the father loves his child as well. 2 This is how we know that we love the children of God: by loving God and carrying out his commands. 3 This is love for God: to obey his commands. And his commands are not burdensome, 4 for everyone born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith. 5 Who is it that overcomes the world? Only he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God.

It's amazing, really, because there aren't ANY enemies, actually, that Jesus hasn't defeated, and given us power and

authority to defeat as well. And that is the beauty of what Jesus accomplished at Easter, and on our behalf. He has done all that is needed for us to have the same victory that He experienced. We just have to make sure we follow Him, living and walking in His footsteps, in His ways of love, and in His Spirit. ... Isaiah spoke these words about Him:

18 "Here is my servant whom I have chosen, the one I love, in whom I delight; I will put my Spirit on him, and he will proclaim justice to the nations.

19 He will not quarrel or cry out; no one will hear his voice in the streets.

20 A bruised reed he will not break, and a smoldering wick he will not snuff out, till he leads justice to victory.

21 In his name the nations will put their hope."

Matthew 12:18-21

Have you experienced this victory in Jesus Christ? Have you received Him, as Lord and King of your heart? Are you overcoming? Have you put your hope in Him? ... There's victory in store for you. There's still the resurrection victory awaiting you.

As you reflect on what He did in this Easter season, make it personal – He did it all for you. The victory in *His* life, death, and resurrection, means victory for you.







Easter is the time of year when we celebrate Jesus's power over sin and death.
