

Built Up Into God's Dwelling Place

When I was in eighth grade, our teacher, Mrs. Madden, gave us an assignment to write an essay about what we wanted to be in the future. We also were given a good sized vellow-brown envelope (they called it a Manila envelope in those days) and told to paint a picture of ourselves in that profession. with water colors.

That sounded pretty good – I liked to paint, and was pretty good at it. The only problem was ... I had no idea what I wanted to become - none whatsoever.

So I had to get creative. I liked art – drawing in particular – and I was good at mathematics, science, and mechanics; so I figured architecture might be good. I also thought it paid pretty well (I really had no idea I was only in eighth grade). So architecture it was.

I don't know, any more, what I wrote, but I remember the picture I painted. Surrounding my prominently centered self-portrait (It didn't turn out to look much like me – so maybe my drawing and painting weren't as good as I thought), I had a T-square, some angles (a 30/60 degree, and a 45), a ruler, and a tall building in the background. All in all, it was pretty good, and since I really didn't know much about architecture, or what else I really wanted to do. I stuck with that.

Even into early high school the idea of architecture stayed with me for a while. I took

a drafting class, and did well with that. It didn't last through high school, however, and as most of you know, I ended up in engineering first, and then in the ministry.

It turns out that God had been doing some architecture work in my life. I didn't really know it in my early years, but looking back in hindsight, it is obvious to me now that God had been building me up over all those years, and building me also into His spiritual house, which is the church of God, and dwelling place of His Holy Spirit. Peter says:

4 As you come to him, the living Stonerejected by men but chosen by God and precious to him- 5 you also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

1 Peter 2:4-5

When I received Christ Jesus, as Lord of my life, He began to shape me, like a dressed stone, and as I continued to walk with Him, in obedience, He carefully placed me exactly where He wanted me, serving Him, in His house.

I didn't know what He had in mind in the early days of my youth, however. I was not following Christ in my early teens. I was resistant and living in the flesh. But somebody must have been praying for me (for sure, my mother was), because eventually, the conviction of the Holy Spirit was inescapable.

He contended with my heart until I could resist Him no longer.

When I finally surrendered to Him, I was unsure whether I could follow Christ. I was afraid that I wouldn't be able to overcome the temptations and desires of the flesh. But God is faithful, and with the help of the Holy Spirit, I made it through the challenging days of my youth. I was at the feet of Jesus and His throne of mercy and grace often, but He taught and nurtured me through the church, and set me like a stone in His house – the temple and dwelling place of His Spirit. As Paul says:

17 He came and preached peace to you who were far away and peace to those who were near. 18 For through him we both have access to the Father by one Spirit. 19 Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and aliens, but fellow citizens with God's people and members of God's household, 20 built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the chief cornerstone. 21 In him the whole building is joined together and rises to become a holy temple in the Lord. 22 And in him you too are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit.

I was being built into His house, as were others – built together to become the dwelling place of God. It's a marvelous experience to be part of God's building project. And along the way, He called me to serve as a builder with Him, joining stones together, as His building continues to rise.

Ephesians 2:17-22

All this was God's plan from the start. This is why He sent Jesus, with His gift of salvation, and the gift of the Holy Spirit: to deliver us from sin and death, to preach peace with God, and to build us up into His household, into His priesthood, and into His dwelling place.

What He did for me, He wants to do for you. And He will do it, if you will surrender your heart, and yield yourself to His power and His will. The strength you don't have, He will supply, through His Spirit of Power. And when you continue in His will, you will find your place in His household, in His priesthood, and in His holy temple. Paul says:

6 So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live in him, 7 rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness.

Colossians 2:6-7

There is blessing awaiting you when you receive Christ Jesus as Lord, and continue in Him. It is the experience of being built up into God's dwelling place, the temple of God's Spirit. There is no place I'd rather be. And I pray the same is true for you.

May the peace of Christ draw you near, and the power of God's Spirit strengthen you, as you yield your life and spirit to God, and as the Father builds you into His glorious house.
























This year, Father's Day is on June 17th, and it all began when a young woman wanted to honor her dad.

In May of 1909, Sonora Smart Dodd of Spokane, Washington, sat in church listening to a Mother's Day sermon. She decided she wanted to designate a day for her dad, William Jackson Smart.

On June 19, 1910, a Father's Day celebration was held at the YMCA in Spokane, Washington by Sonora Smart Dodd. Her father, a civil war veteran, was a single parent who raised his six children there.

However, it was not until 1972, 58 years after President Woodrow Wilson made Mother's Day official, that the day honoring *fathers* became a nationwide holiday in the United States.


God took the strength of a mountain, The greatest gift


