Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures.

He was buried

He was raised on the 3rd day according to the Scriptures.

He appeared to the disciples, and to 500+.

# How To Understand the Work of Christ

Why is it important that Jesus rose from the dead?

1 Corinthians 15:20-25

He is the first of those raised from the dead.

Death came to all by one man (Adam), so resurrection (life) comes to all by one man (Christ).

The order is Christ first; then those who belong to Him, when He comes; then the end will come.

He destroys all dominion, authority and power, then turns over the kingdom to God the Father.

He rose so that we too would rise and live with Him.
