

### Family of GOD

**Definition of** *family 1* : A group of individuals living under one roof and usually under one head : <u>household 2a</u> : A group of persons of <u>common ancestry : **Synonyms** <u>blood, clan, folks, house, kin, kindred, kinfolk (or kinfolks), kinsfolk, line, lineage, people, race, stock, tribe.</u></u>

When I started thinking about the word family, the first thing that came to mind was that commercial for ancestry.com. I thought, wouldn't it be amazing, if they could go back about 5000 years? Because if they could, it would show the beginning of the first families and where we all started from - at least after the flood. Another thing I was imagining was, what if they could show us that family tree, and what it would look like? I picture this very large tree with a lot of branches going back about 2500 years, and then the tree would start to look like it was upside down, because all those branches would start becoming less.... and less. It would then end up with 3 Roots, the sons from Noah and their wives.

I did a google search on Noah's ark and found a lot of different stories. One of them showed that they found this large wooden ship that happens to be almost exactly the same dimensions as stated in the Bible, and it happens to be in the mountains of Ararat, also stated in the Bible. And another funny thing is it's 13000 feet above sea level. I wonder who built a large wooden ship at 13000 feet above sea level, on a mountain about 4800 years ago? That guy must have been crazy, or maybe that is where it came to rest. Now I'm thinking that a lot of you have already seen this, or heard about it, because it is old news - about 3400 years old. But it seemed in line with the topic of family, and showing even more proof of our ancestry. Now, I know those of us in this

special family don't need more proof, but it could mean something to those that are not yet a part of our family. So we need to show those people what a true family of God is like.

Whenever I do a newsletter, I always look up that topic word in the concordance section of my study Bible. This helps me a lot, so I can read all the Scriptures using that word and think about the ones that seem to stand out to me. Now, the word family is only shown 7 or 8 times in my concordance, and none of those Scriptures jumped out at me, so.... I did more searching for father, mother, brother and sister and as you could imagine I had lot to read. The first one that came to me led me to the next one, which I have had underlined for a long time, because I liked it a lot, and it really tells us what the true family of God should be like.

**1 Corinthians 13:4-8** "Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. <sup>5</sup>It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. <sup>6</sup>Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. <sup>7</sup>It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. <sup>8</sup>Love never fails."

If we have this kind of love for everyone we will be with the true family of God. Now, back to the first one:

**1 Corinthians 12:12-27 (Unity and Diversity in the Body)** "<sup>12</sup> Just as a body, though one, has many parts, but all its many parts form one body, so it is with Christ. <sup>13</sup> For we were all baptized by one Spirit so as to form one body-whether Jews or Gentiles, slave or free-and we were all given the

one Spirit to drink. <sup>14</sup> Even so the body is not made up of one part but of many..."

"17 ... If the whole body were an eye, where would the sense of hearing be? If the whole body were an ear, where would the sense of smell be? 18 But in fact God has placed the parts in the body, every one of them, just as he wanted them to be. 19 If they were all one part, where would the body be? 20 As it is, there are many parts, but one body.

<sup>21</sup> The eye cannot say to the hand, "I don't need you!" And the head cannot say to the feet, "I don't need you!" <sup>22</sup> On the contrary, those parts of the body that seem to be weaker are indispensable, <sup>23</sup> and the parts that we think are less honorable we treat with special honor.

But God has put the body together, giving greater honor to the parts that lacked it, <sup>25</sup> so that there should be no division in the body, but that its parts should have equal concern for each other. <sup>26</sup> If one part suffers, every part suffers with it; if one part is honored, every part rejoices with it. <sup>27</sup>Now you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it."

When I read this, it made me think of my own actual body, and I thought about the times when I was injured: like the time I sprained my pinky finger, and the time I had a torn muscle. Those parts of my body were hurting, and it made things a lot harder for me to accomplish, especially the things I needed to do. Most of you know that I work on heavy equipment. It was very difficult for me during those injuries to perform the work that I had to do. Sometimes I could only use one arm, when both would have made it easier. And when I tried to install mounting nuts and bolts with a very sore finger, it just made everything so much harder. Just like it says, if one part suffers, every part suffers and that should be especially true for us in the family of God.

When I came to you, I did not come with eloquence or human wisdom as I proclaimed to you the testimony about God. <sup>2</sup> For I resolved to know nothing while I was with you except Jesus Christ and him crucified. <sup>3</sup> I came to you in weakness with great fear and trembling. <sup>4</sup> My message and my preaching were not with wise and persuasive words, but with a demonstration of the Spirit's power, <sup>5</sup> so that your faith might not rest on human wisdom, but on God's power.

Our family tree all starts at the same root; so let us all be a part of God's Family.



The next Elder's Meeting will be held on Wednesday, February 22<sup>nd</sup> for the month of March.



The NICE Foundation is in need of churches to partner with them to continue to feed the children in Nicaragua.


