

### **Our Journey in God's Kingdom**

1 Peter 2:4-5 As you come to him, the living Stone, rejected by men but chosen by God and precious to Him, you also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

1 Peter 2:9 -10 But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of the darkness into his wonderful light. Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.

We all have a choice to make.

2 Peter 2:10-11 Therefore, my brothers, be all the more eager to make your calling and election sure. For if you do these things, you will never fail, and you will receive a rich welcome into the eternal kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

God has called all of us to enter his kingdom. He has not made any distinction between which peoples to offer this gift. It is offered to all who inhabit this Earth. All were created in God's perfection with the ability to enter his kingdom. It is our choice, our "election," to decide if we want to receive such a wonderful gift. Do you want to receive the gift of eternal life and all of the wonders of heaven? I cannot imagine anyone who could possibly say no to this question. The alternative to choosing his kingdom is to spend eternity in the pain and terrors of hell.

Okay, so let's assume that you want to spend eternity in God's kingdom in Heaven. You have made your election, and now must take the actions necessary to insure your welcome

into the eternal kingdom that Peter is talking about.

2 Peter 1:3-4 His divine power has given us <u>everything</u> we need for life and godliness through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness. Through these he has given us his very great and precious promises, so that through them you may participate in the divine nature and escape the corruption in the world caused by evil desires.

What is <u>everything</u> that he has given us to make our journey into his heavenly kingdom possible? To enter the kingdom we must do so as perfect spiritual beings without sin on our souls. Sounds like a tough job, and indeed it is. Without Jesus and the Holy Spirit we would be doomed and never be able to achieve our goal.

Here is how it works.

Romans 3:22-26 This righteousness from God comes through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. There is no difference, for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus. God presented him as a sacrifice for atonement, through faith in his blood. He did this to demonstrate his justice, because in his forbearance he had left the sins committed beforehand unpunished- he did it to demonstrate his justice at the present time, so as to be just and the one who justifies those who have faith in Jesus.

At the time we accept Jesus as our Lord and Savior, and accept all that he teaches, our past sins are swept away and forgotten, as if they never existed. We have reached a level where we would

A good example is the thief on the cross next to Jesus. He expressed his belief in Jesus and accepted him completely. He was purified and justified and told by Jesus that they would meet again in heaven.

This is wonderful except that by his skills alone, man cannot defeat the flesh and continue to live in purity. He must be pure to enter heaven! So, there is a bit of a hurdle to face here, but all is not lost. To obtain a complete look at His Kingdom we must be ever cautious to not sin, with the help of the Holy Spirit, and keep our minds and hearts focused on Jesus. Our time on Earth is limited as we are simply passing through. We are travelers with the goal of reaching His Kingdom.

Review of the Sunny Place Church of God Purpose, Vision, and Mission

Ephesians 1:9-10 "he made known to us the mystery if his will according to his good pleasure, which he purposed in Christ to be put into effect when the times reach their fulfillment – to bring all things in heaven and on earth under Christ."

Pastor Pete prepared several possible structures for the Elders and Ministries. There was discussion and it was agreed that Pastor Pete will bring together the ministry team leaders and elders to discuss the possible structure.

There was discussion about each ministry reviewing the team mission, objectives and update as needed. Sam mentioned that each team's mission is listed on the Sunny Place web site. Teams should pray, seeking to identify Christ's direction. The written objectives should be a guide to evaluate the effectiveness of the team. Pastor Pete suggested the fall is a good time to do this review when the next year activities are being planned and the budget is discussed.

The church health and natural church develop was reviewed. Pastor Pete showed a comparison of the last two years this survey was conducted which showed great improvements in several areas. He is searching for another organization that would provide a survey similar to the previous surveys.

Leadership and discipleship were discussed at length. Pastor Pete showed two videos of speakers from the global leadership conference held last year. Mark Miller offered a definition of leadership; Psalm 78:72 the integrity of heart and skillful hands. To see a picture of the future, a vision, and to engage those you select, to invest themselves fully into the vision of the future were ideas. There were five questions asked about leadership. They were to define, to teach, to practice, to measure and model leadership. Sam Adeyemi from Nigeria spoke about leadership from the inside out. He emphasized seeing people, not as they are, but as they can be; and helping them to become what they can become in the vision of the church.

Pastor Pete is committed to bring leadership and discipleship teaching or training to Sunny Place and the Elders have complete agreement with these efforts.

The next Elders meeting will be May 2.




