When we accept Jesus as our Lord and Savior, submitting our will to His perfect plan, the Apostle Paul explains the transformation. "to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires, to be made new in the attitude of your minds; and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness." Ephesians 4: 22-24

Spiritual gifts as an investment

When we put on the new self, the Spiritual gifts come from the Father, through the Son by the Holy Spirit. The Holy Trinity invests in us. The gifts can be preaching the word, administration of the church, healing, encouraging, prophesying, contributing to the needs of others, leadership, hospitality, wisdom, discernment, or showing mercy. Jesus is the divine example of the spiritual gifts. His life is true holiness and Paul explains the greatest of these gifts; "If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but have not love, I am nothing." 1 Corinthians 13:2

Love is a spiritual gift from our Lord and a commandment to obey.

"One of these, an expert in the law, tested him with this question: 'Teacher which is

the greatest commandment in the Law?' Jesus replied, 'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: "Love your neighbor as yourself." All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments." Matthew 22: 35-40

In this calling, we can be assured He will equip us for each assignment. The Holy Spirit's empowerment will enable us to do His work, even when we are unsure of our abilities or the desired result. At times, we may think our work is not of great value, particularly if we compare our lives to others. This is untrue, a lie from the



Ministry Reminders:



The next Elder's meeting will be on Wednesday, November 3rd.








Thanksgiving Maze






