### **God's Instructions for Success**

Wrinkled noses and puckered lips – sometimes this is people's reaction when they hear about my latest escapade. Especially, when I share why I have decided to be involved in this small business venture I believe I will have success in, which is something definitely different than my norm.

What does it mean to believe?...When I think of the word believe I also think of the word faith. Is there a difference? In some ways there doesn't seem to be a difference. We see the word being interchangeable. Faith is more of a force that comes from out of our spirit. It's a gift from God. But I think believing -choosing to believe mentally, or to agree with God - is what unleashes the force of faith we have in God.

Recently, I had a breakthrough with a marketing technique. I attended a conference on how to market your small business. I jotted down all the keynotes the speaker spoke about, and took snap shots of all the pointer slides for future reference. Without that set of instructions, I knew the next time I would advertise on social media I would flop.

"When Jesus rose early on the very first day of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene...She went and told those who had been with him and who were mourning and weeping. When they heard that Jesus was alive and that she had seen him, they did not believe it." Mark16:9-11 (NIV) The disciples didn't believe it?! But Jesus had told them over and over again that He would be crucified and raised again on the third day...you see the disciples had faith in Jesus; they knew he was the Messiah. But they didn't believe He was going to do what He said He would do. It's just like many Christians today. They have faith in God, but they don't always believe the promises of God - what He tells us in His word.

"Be strong and courageous...Do not let this Book of Law depart from your mouth, meditate on in it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful." – Joshua 1: 6a, 8 (NIV)

Without God's instructions, Joshua would have failed at leading the Israelites into the Promised Land. The first was to "be strong and courageous" (Josh 1:6). Next, he was to continually meditate on the Book of the Law; and finally, he was to do everything it said. As long as Joshua followed the directions, God promised him "success" (v.8).

Tim and I love to travel, to see and experience new sites. Recently, I came across an article on Jamaica featuring Ocho Rios, home of Dunn's River Falls - a spectacle that never ceases to amaze people who visit there. Water cascades down a long series of rocks as it makes its way to the Caribbean Sea. Adventurers can climb the falls, scrambling over rounded rocks on an invigorating trek to the top. The flowing water, the potentially slippery surface, and the steep angles make the going slow and a bit treacherous.


To make it safely to the top, climbers must watch every step. If a person is not careful, he or she could fall on the journey. The keys to a successful climb are concentration and caution.

## "See then that you walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise" - Ephesians 5:15 (KJV)

God's "instructions for success" can work for us too, but His idea of success has little to do with money, popularity, or even good health. In the original Hebrew, from Joshua 1:8, "then you will have good success" means "then you will act wisely". Just as God called Joshua to walk in wisdom, He wants us to "walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise". (Eph 5:15)

I can't think of a better picture of what Paul is saying in Ephesians 5:15 when he says "walk circumspectly." We should be "very careful...how {we} live (NIV). Clearly, with all of life's possible dangers coming our way, as we climb through life, it is vital that we take each step with Jesus wisely and cautiously believing in Him. A fool, the passage says, lives carelessly; a wise person watches each step, so he does not stumble or fall.

When we were children we had no problem in believing. But isn't it interesting that the more mature we get, and the smarter we think we get, the less we are able to believe? However, our unbelief




can cause us to miss out on the very things God has planned for us.

I think that maybe sometimes we lose our belief because we ask God for something and don't get it. But have you ever thought that maybe He didn't want you to have it because He had something better ready for you?


#### Ministry Reminders:






