

### Communion: The Gift of Love and knowledge

The act of communion brings two different thoughts to mind. It is actually a continuation of the same action bringing us together in the fellowship with God. The act of breaking bread together in the Lord's Supper is an acknowledgement of the parts of the body of Christ that we, as the church, are all a part of. Secondly, it is the act of sharing, and exchanging, intimate thoughts and feelings on a spiritual level. I would like to write about the communion of the Holy Ghost, as written in 2 Corinthians 13:14. "May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit, be with you all."

The word communion, in the Bible, is translated from the Greek word and means "sharing", which Paul used to describe the taking of bread and wine as the body and blood of Christ. The use of the word communion in the a Bible is very extensive and is seen in Genesis 18:33. "And the LORD went his way, as soon as he had left communing with Abraham: and Abraham returned unto his place." In Acts 2:42, "They devoted themselves to the apostles teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer." These verses show us the closeness, togetherness, and connection we have with God and other Christians.

In our communion with the Holy Spirit, we have the ability to have constant and continual connection with God. There is a constant readiness on His part to admit us

into His presence, and listen to all that we say. We are encouraged to give everything to Him. We need to empty ourselves of all that is of this world, and seek the arms of the Savior. God's interest in us is so great that He is willing to talk to us, and guide us through our slightest injustice, trials and difficulties. God does this without ever getting tired, or impatient; God has a great interest in us.

Every true Christian knows what it is to feel a secret moving of the heart toward God. It is a silent, but deep, and powerful drawing away of the soul from the world. We feel ourselves being pulled away from everything into a sacred and private interview with God.

Through communion with the Holy Spirit, we are able to see how weak we are; and with continual temptation surrounding us, how easily we may be overcome. It is only by the grace of God, that we are saved, and at that time, we are sure we are in communion with God. It is only when we are able to open up our hearts, exposing our deepest thoughts, emotions, affections and secrets will we know we are in communion with Him.

When we commune with God, sometimes we find ourselves pleading and reasoning with Him; we want to influence the mind of God. In Genesis 32:22-28, "That night Jacob got up and took his two wives, his two female servants and his eleven sons and crossed the ford of the Jabbok. <sup>23</sup> After he had sent them

across the stream, he sent over all his possessions. <sup>24</sup> So Jacob was left alone, and a man wrestled with him till daybreak. <sup>25</sup> When the man saw that he could not overpower him, he touched the socket of Jacob's hip so that his hip was wrenched as he wrestled with the man. <sup>26</sup> Then the man said, "Let me go, for it is daybreak." But Jacob replied, "I will not let you go unless you bless me." <sup>27</sup> The man asked him, "What is your name?" "Jacob," he answered. <sup>28</sup> Then the man said, "Your name will no longer be Jacob, but Israel, <sup>[a]</sup> because you have struggled with God and with humans and have overcome." We need to take hold of every strength of God, and hold fast to His faithfulness and promises.

When we make God our sacred confidant, and tell Him all those secret things which we would tell no other in the universe, we are in a state of communion with our Lord. Romans 8:22-26, <sup>22</sup> We know that the whole creation has been groaning as in the pains of childbirth right up to the present time. <sup>23</sup> Not only so, but we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly for our adoption to sonship, the redemption of our bodies. <sup>24</sup> For in this hope we were saved. But hope that is seen is no hope at all. Who hopes for what they already have? <sup>25</sup> But if we hope for what we do not yet have, we wait for it patiently. <sup>26</sup> In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us through wordless groans."






