Key Questions for Review

What is prayer? Heb 4:16; Phil 4:6; Rev 19:4

Approaching the throne of grace for mercy, grace & help; presenting requests & thanks to God; worship

Why should we pray? Ps 62:8; Jer 33:3; Eph 3:20
God is our refuge; He tells great & unsearchable things; He is able to do more than we can ask or imagine

What are some barriers to effective prayer? Ps 66:18; Matt 6:5-7,15; John 9:31; Isaiah 1:11-15

Sin; hypocrisy, pride, lack of remission for others; unrighteousness What are some pre-requisites to effective prayer? Ps

66:18; Matt 21:22; Jn 15:7, 16:24; 1 Jn 5:14-15

Faith; remaining in Christ; asking in Jesus' name; asking in His will

Why did Daniel pray? vv1-3 (see also v20b)

What kind of prayer was this? vv3-4a

What does he begin with? v4b

In this confession, what does he say about the people? How detailed is it? What does he

say about God? w5-14

What does Daniel appeal to? vv15-19

When did God answer? How? vv20-23

# Examples of Communicating With God

Prayer of Nehemiah: Nehemiah 1:1-11

Why did Nehemiah pray? vv1-3 (see also v11)

What kind of prayer was this? vv3-4

What does he begin with? v5

What does he say about the people? vv6b-7

What does Daniel appeal to? vv8-9

Regarding the people, who is he praying that God would listen to? w10-11
