

All Scripture is Given by Inspiration of God

Over the course of the 1800s and into the early 1900s, it was common for medicine shows to travel across the country from town to town. These medicine shows combined various forms of popular entertainment and sales pitches, usually from a self-proclaimed "doctor" who sold a so-called amazing cureall medicine. Pitchmen would make lavish claims about their product's effectiveness, sometimes planting testimonials in the audience to help support their claims. It was said that these cure-all medicines had the ability to cure all kinds of diseases, smooth wrinkles, remove stains, prolong life or cure any number of common ailments. These cure -all medicines seldom treated the specific symptoms of an illness, instead relying on stimulants or other drugs to produce a pleasurable effect. These cure-all medicines offered claims that seem like many of the false and unfulfilling things of this world that only bring temporary relief and happiness.

These medicine shows with their made-up miracle claims of healing made me stop and think about an authentic book that offers inspirational true claims of wisdom, divine understanding, and forgiveness of sin, which leads to eternal life, The Bible... All Scripture is given by inspiration of God. 2 Timothy 3:16-17 (NIV) "All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work."

That's quite amazing! The apostle Paul was saying that God gave us the Bible to teach us about Himself, to give us practical instructions on how to live, and to equip us completely with everything we need to know in order to live a fulfilling and godly life on this earth.

In Deuteronomy 4, Moses urged the Israelites to listen carefully to the rules and regulations he was teaching them (v. 1). He reminded them that the source and inspiration behind the teaching was none other than God Himself, who had spoken to them "out of the fire" of Mount Sinai (v. 12). Moses said, "He declared to you his covenant, the Ten Commandments, which he commanded you to follow" (v. 13).

The Bible is God's holy, inspired, infallible Word. Scripture comes to us from God's heart. Therefore, we must guard its message with integrity by "rightly dividing the word of truth" 2 Timothy 2:15 (NKJV). We must respect its every word. To take Scripture out of context, or twist its meaning to serve our purposes, or justify our own opinions is to dishonor God's Word and His name.




