The Divine Synergetic Community

Synergy defined as the creation of a whole that is greater than the simple sum of its parts. Synergy is seen throughout the fingerprint of God's creation. True synergy is the divine dynamic energy synthesized and working together in the spirit of oneness for a higher calling.

Who we are and what we see did not evolve in an isolated genesis. We are created in a "let us" synergetic manner. God created Adam. He knew it was "not good" for him "to be alone." It is in the to-gather-ness where synergy is released, experienced, and expanded.

"And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth (Genesis 1:26)."

We are created in a synergetic way to live in a milieu of to-gather-ness because the synergy is very much part of our created DNA. I would like you to observe the plurality of creation in the above verse, "Let us make," "in our image," "after our likeness." The synergy of triune God is clearly evident in His creation.

The dynamic power of synergy happens in a state of oneness that we could never create in isolation! Even after the creation, the Lord God said that

"It is NOT good that the man should be alone..."

Here God portrays the opposite of synergy is not good. Therefore, God's solution was to make a helper. God breathed divine anesthesia into the man. God performed the first surgery and brought forth a woman. And God shared the formula to experience the synergetic effect.

"... they will "leave" and "cleave" to become "one ..."

Remember that synergy is released when we leave our past connection and cleave to the new oneness that God has for us. Many times, hanging on to the past life can bring distortion, division, destruction, and desolution. Sometimes we distract ourselves with other things that give us instant gratification and end up having no time for the new oneness God gave us. And if we continue in that path, God's word, God's people become just a word in the book and a voice in the mouth of the preacher. Then our eyes become blind, our hearts become calloused, and grieving Holy Spirit becomes a pattern of life. It is a dark and dangerous place to be. Remember the Lord God's solution is to cleave to the one He gave us to bring a dynamic synergetic oneness.

"God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son" for us...


Jesus fulfilled the love of God in a synergetic

fashion. He did not attempt to complete His mission alone. He called his disciples from all disciplines, walking together, working together, eating together, spending quality time together, sharing together, and making them worthy of His calling. It is the unity in togetherness that make us synergetic. Therefore, Jesus prayed for the oneness of his disciples:

"... Holy Father, keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one, as we are" (John 17:11).

Yes, let us "be one, as We are" - the synergetic voice of triune oneness!

Synergy happens when our lives come in connection with others to create something we could never produce alone. When we are one in the name of Jesus, there is God's presence.



"Again, I tell you truly that if two of you on the earth agree about anything you ask for, it will be done for you by My Father in heaven. For where two or three gather together in My name, there am I with them" (Matthew 18:19-20).

True Synergy is possible with the presence and communion of the Holy Spirit. Now the Holy Spirit is the helper, God has given us. Therefore, let us not grieve the Holy Spirit! Paul concludes his letter to

the Corinthian Church with the communion kept between the Holy Spirit and his saints:

"The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit, be with you all. Amen." (2 Corinthians 13:14)

New and Old Business


- Pastor Pete and Carla will be on vacation from Sept 23 to Oct 6th
