

## The Truth, and Nothing but the Truth

Kids Definition of truthful: Telling, or being, in the habit of telling facts, or making statements that are true. Fullness: The quality, or state, of being filled completely, or to utmost capacity.

Have you ever seen the movie A Few Good Men with Jack Nicholson and Tom Cruise? The part where Colonel Jessup is on the stand and Tom said, "I want the truth! Then Colonel Jessup (Jack Nicholson) yelled, "You can't handle the truth!

In my mind that statement makes me think of all the people that don't go to church, or won't go to church, or even the non-believers. Could it be because they don't think God can handle the truth about them, or maybe they don't want to know the truth about God, because that might cause them to have to change their ways?

John 3:19-21 <sup>19</sup> This is the verdict: Light has come into the world, but people loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil. <sup>20</sup> Everyone who does evil hates the light, and will not come into the light for fear that their deeds will be exposed. <sup>21</sup> But whoever lives by the truth comes into the light, so that it may be seen plainly that what they have done has been done in the sight of God.

We know God can handle the truth because he is the truth, as Jesus stated to Thomas in:

John 14:5-7 <sup>5</sup> Thomas said to him, "Lord, we don't know where you are going, so how can we know the way?" <sup>6</sup> Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. <sup>7</sup> If you really know me, you will know my Father as well. From now on, you do know him and have seen him."

So not *just* the truth, but the way and the life.

Another thing that came to mind, when thinking about the word "Truthfulness," was that thing they have you do before you go up on the witness stand in courts. I don't know if they still do that, but it was always something in the back of my mind. They have you put one hand up, and the other hand on the Bible and say, "Do you swear to tell the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, so help you God?" I often wondered why they would do that unless they knew that person was a Christian, a true believer. If they aren't Christian, and don't know God, what is the point? They might as well have them put their hand on the "Green Eggs & Ham" book, and the other hand on their head. We know they will do, or say, anything for their own benefit.

Proverbs 14:25 <sup>25</sup>A truthful witness saves lives, but a false witness is deceitful.

Proverbs 12: 19 <sup>19</sup>Truthful lips endure forever, but a lying tongue lasts only a moment.

I think we as Christians need to be that witness on the stand every day, to show the truthfulness of God to those that don't know him. And I found some good Scriptures that help simplify it, at least for me.

Ephesians 5:8-9 <sup>8</sup> For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Live as children of light <sup>9</sup> (for the fruit of the light consists in all goodness, righteousness and truth) <sup>10</sup> and find out what pleases the Lord.

Paul writing to Timothy:

1 Timothy 2:1-6 <sup>1</sup>I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people— <sup>2</sup> for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful

and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. <sup>3</sup> This is good, and pleases God our Savior, <sup>4</sup> who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth. <sup>5</sup> For there is one God and one mediator between God and mankind, the man Christ Jesus, <sup>6</sup> who gave himself as a ransom for all people.

1 Timothy 3:14-15 <sup>14</sup> Although I hope to come to you soon, I am writing you these instructions so that, <sup>15</sup> if I am delayed, you will know how people ought to conduct themselves in God's household, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and foundation of the truth.

Zechariah 8:16-17 <sup>16</sup> These are the things you are to do: Speak the truth to each other, and render true and sound judgment in your courts; <sup>17</sup> do not plot evil against each other, and do not love to swear falsely. I hate all this," declares the LORD.

John 4:23-24 <sup>23</sup> Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in the Spirit and in truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks. <sup>24</sup> God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in the Spirit and in truth."

Ephesians 1:13 And you also were included in Christ when you heard the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation.

I know I use a lot of Scripture in my articles, but I can't help it, because Scripture explains more about truthfullness than I could in my own words.

One thing I learned when I was much younger: it was always better for me to tell the truth, than to lie, mainly because I had such a bad memory that I couldn't remember the lies I told, and seemed to get caught all the time. I also know it is much easier for me to remember the truth than a lie, because the truth is real, and a lie is made up.

One last thing I just thought of. Do you remember that

Ephesians 4:14-16 <sup>14</sup> Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of people in their deceitful scheming. <sup>15</sup> Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ. <sup>16</sup> From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work.


