He is the one and only constant in our lives, dependable, totally reliable. Change surrounds us and carries us places we never thought we would go. Change can bring hardship and suffering when it occurs suddenly. We can call upon the living God who is always near, never far away. We can confidently teach our children and our

children's children about the Living God and His divine qualities since we know He will reign forever, from one generation to another.

We learn more about the Majestic living God from the Apostle Paul who says;

"Now to the King eternal, immortal, invisible, the only God, be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen" 1 Timothy 1:17

The Apostle Paul describes the greatness; the supremacy of Christ in the first chapter of Colossians:




