Achievement: The Love of Christ Demonstrated in Tangible Ways

One thousand-nine-hundred miles as the crow flies, lies an island named Hispaniola which consists of the two countries of The Dominican Republic and Haiti, with a population of twenty-one million. Towards the middle south portion of Hispaniola lies a City named Barahona.

In Barahona, there is a single two-story resort with government plated vehicles that lies next to the sparkling blue Caribbean. This resort stands out like a jewel to the tourists who are none the wiser, but the true and pure beauty of Barahona lies in the beautiful natives who sleep on the streets and in the makeshift homes placed together with material from frequent storms that blow garbage and debris. Two and a half hours east of Barahona is Santa Domingo, a thriving metropolis which would fool the common visitor into thinking the island was something different from the third world country that it truly is.

The concrete hotel in Barahona has no coverings on the windows and has no doors on the entrances to the building. There was a security man on a donkey who would chase any thief. After turning off the flashlight in bed you would only have to count to 10 before turning it on only to watch cockroaches scatter, usually 40 at a time.

At 5:00 AM, it was time for my daily run through the city and then along the ocean. The five-year-old boys were already washing a few cars, placing windshield wipers up, waiting for the owners to come out to receive a few coins. It wasn't about twenty feet before I started jumping over sleeping bodies strewn about the streets and sidewalks like a bomb had detonated. As the sun cut through the sea slowly the bodies became less.

Christ's achievement here on earth is unparalleled. It is only by His fulfillment of the prophecies and His gift of the Holy Spirit, we now can achieve eternal salvation with Him. The world definition of achievement is a noun- a thing done successfully, typically by effort, courage, or skill.

By the world's definition the resort in Barahona had reached achievement; it was a fine building with much food, safety, and lavish materials and was placed on the shores of the Caribbean Sea. Santa Domingo was a huge city that could easily fool people into thinking great achievements had been made.

Matthew 16:26 says, "For what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world and forfeits his soul?"

We were sent to the specific place in Barahona to build homes for Habitat for Humanity in the late 1990s. There was a clear divide between the rich and the poor and there was also a clear divide between the righteous and the unrighteous .

The smiles on the children, mothers and fathers were larger than life. Their laughter could not be contained. The homes we built were with simple concrete blocks, with a concrete roof, and one room to sleep in and one to cook in. The whole community helped achieve a little bit of stability, working in the hot sun.

Matthew 18:3 says, "Truly I tell you unless you change and become like children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven." 1 Corinthians 13:13 states: "Faith, hope and love but the greatest of these is love."

I do not remember any sadness in the community, just a love of Christ that was apparent, and demonstrated in real and tangible ways, especially in the ability to share what limited resources they had. They had big smiles, laughter and a meal that would include the whole village, combining tables and chairs that would stretch out into the mud. All tables where joined together, as we joyfully shared a meal together. They had nothing and they gave everything!

Romans 6:20–23 says, "for when you were slaves of sin, you were free in regard to righteousness. What fruit did you have then in the things of which you are now ashamed? For the end of those things is death. But now having been set free from sin and becoming slaves of God, you have fruit to holiness and its end, eternal life. For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."

In summary, as you trod with the Holy Spirit remember what Paul said in Philippians 1:27– 28; "Whatever happens, conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ. Then, whether I come and see you or only hear about you in my absence, I will know that you stand firm in the one spirit, striving together as one for the faith of the gospel without being frightened in anyway by those who oppose you. This is a sign to them that they will be destroyed, but you will be saved and that by God. "This is scripture to live by.


